WATER RATIO LIMITS

2 litres of clean water per 5kg container. Add water first then compound, mix mechanically into lump free paste. At 23°C pot life is 10 - 15mins. Higher temperatures shorten. Lower temperature extends.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Prior to use the substrate must be clean and structurally sound, remove any flaking or loose material, grind if necessary. The substrate should be dust free and vacuumed, with no traces of waxy residue, coatings, powder, grease or oil etc. present. Dusty floors must be consolidated.

APPLICATION TEMPERATURE

Apply at a temperature between 5°C and 35°C.

APPLICATION

Add water as specified above. Mix until a lump free uniform paste is formed. Do not add extra water or mix with other materials
Spread slurry with trowel to a maximum height of 3mm
Trowel within 15 - 20 minutes of mixing.
Whilst curing avoid direct sunlight and strong draughts.
Allow to cure naturally.
